This funding will be used to

- Drive the schools Annual Improvement Plan to build capacity in staff knowledge and understanding of Australian Curriculum.
- Prioritise student engagement and academic success by improving A-E levels of achievement - lifting English A-C results by 10% and Maths A-C results by 5%.
- Build teachers' data literacy skills.
- Develop and support a school-wide approach to supporting diverse learners.
- Implement wellbeing and social emotional interventions and engagement programs that focus on inclusion and support student attendance that meet the students needs.

Our initiatives include

- Build teacher capacity by providing planning time for all teachers with Head of Department – Curriculum (HOD-C), Deputy Principal or Principal through Positive Learning Teams (PLT) as a critical driver of learning excellence and student academic achievement.
- Engagement with North Coast Region 'Leading the Learning' project including teacher walk throughs.
- Implementation of targeted programs across P-6 to support student, engagement, attendance and well-being.
- Targeted Teacher Aide support in primary year levels to enhance school improvement priorities, including early identification and speech language support.
- Building student efficacy as learners through the explicit use of learning walls and feedback.
